MEMO: 2020 Spring Term Proceeding

We know that many are wondering what our plan is for the spring and summer. Algoma University has determined that the University **will proceed** with the 2020 Spring/Summer term, with some adjustments necessary in order to respond to the COVID-19 situation. We have created a plan that we hope will minimize disruptions to students' progress through their degrees, and help everyone be ready to continue in the fall term, too.

This information applies to **all campuses** of Algoma University.

Here are the dates for each Spring/Summer session:

- 20SF = June 1 July 10 (exams July 13-14)
- o 20SP = June 1 August 25 (exams Aug 26-31)
- 20SS = July 15 August 25 (exams Aug 26-31)

## Please note:

- Spring/summer classes will be offered through remote and/or online delivery
- The University w.ill work with external experts as needed to ensure the best quality of program delivery
- The deposit deadline has been extended for ALL students to April 30th with final payment due on June 1st, 2020.
- Students wishing to stay on campus for the Spring/Summer semester should fill out the residence application

## **IMPORTANT CHANGE:**

Given the challenges caused by COVID-19, all current/returning <u>International students</u> need to deposit only \$1,000.00 by April 30th to reserve their spot in spring/summer classes.

We are working to offer as much of the Spring roster as possible through a variety of remote delivery options. The original spring timetable will change, of course--we will communicate further detail on specific course offerings and sessions in the very near future. *Once the revised Spring roster is out*, questions can be directed to advising@algomau.ca.
