MEMO: Approved Quarantine Readiness Plan

Through the efforts of the Quarantine Readiness Team, Algoma University has been registered with the Government of Canada as a Designated Learning Institution (DLI) with a Provincially Approved Quarantine Readiness Plan. This plan outlines the steps required when an international student attempts to enter Canada as a member of the Algoma University community, and provides details on how our institution is prepared to support these students.

Details of the plan were posted on the <u>Algoma University website</u> on Monday, November 2, 2020. Please take a moment to review the details of the Quarantine Readiness Plan in an effort to ensure that all members of the Algoma University community have a working understanding of what it entails in order to offer the best possible support to our students.

As you will note in the plan, student travel will be supported in line with the start of the Winter 2021 term, with the first students being accepted on Dec 1, 2020. This date has been determined to ensure students have time to properly prepare, complete mandatory pre- arrival sessions, travel and properly quarantine prior to the start of the Winter 2021 term.

Please note, **we will not be supporting travel on the following dates due to holiday closures on all campuses: December 24, 25, 26, 27, 31, 2020 and January 1, 2021. We will continue to support students already in Canada on these dates.
