Today, the Ontario Government <u>announced</u> that Northern Ontario (Sault Ste. Marie/Timmins) will remain in lockdown for an additional 14 days extending the preventative lockdown measures put in place on December 26th to help keep case counts in Ontario from surging.

The Ontario government has reiterated the need for <u>everyone</u> to do their part in following public health orders. Our communities are being impacted and we urge the Algoma University community to continue to adhere to all measures put in place. Our collective efforts will make a difference.

The Sault Ste. Marie Campus will be extending the current campus closure until January 25, 2021. Some limited services will be available starting January 11th. Please see full details outlined below.

The **Timmins Campus** will follow Northern College's direction on closures and use of space.

As previously announced, the **Brampton Campus will remain closed until January 25, 2021.** All employees will continue working from home except for emergencies.

A permission to be on campus list has been generated to support essential services (i.e. Research, IT and Physical Plant). If you have not been notified that you are on the list, you are expected to work from home during this period.

WINTER 2021 SEMESTER UPDATE

Winter term classes will commence on Monday, January 18th via asynchronous [Brightspace] and synchronous [technologically assisted instruction] delivery.

At present, those classes/laboratories originally scheduled for face-to-face instruction will be via technology assistance for the week of January 18th. Updates will be provided as new information becomes available.

SERVICE IMPACTS FOR SAULT STE. MARIE

Library - will remain closed until January 25. Curbside pick-up will be available starting January 18.

Computer Labs - Will remain closed until further notice.
