MEMO: Covid-19 updates - Reopening and Fall Planning

With promising vaccination numbers and the accelerated move to Step 2 of reopening our province, we look forward to a different, yet more familiar, return to campus activities in the near future. We will now begin to hold small meetings inside and larger groups outside (see details below) Based on recent discussions, we are extremely optimistic that the Ontario government will continue to lift public health restrictions as we move into the fall. Until then, we will continue to follow public health directives as required and ensure the safety and wellbeing of the AU community continues to be our number one priority.

STEP 2 REOPENING PROVINCIAL DIRECTIVES

The Provincial government recently <u>announced</u> that Ontario will be **entering Step 2 of reopening on Wednesday, June 30, 2021**.

Brampton Campus:

We are happy to announce that the Brampton campus will be open to employees starting July 5, 2021, and we are excited to start welcoming back students in August. With this being said, our direct services will remain virtual for the time being.

For our Brampton campus employees, please work directly with your management officer around your schedule. You will receive a separate memo outlining the details of your return and any health and safety information you may need to feel safe upon your return.

Timmins Campus:

After being under an emergency order for some time, the Porcupine Region will enter Step 2 as of June 30, 2021. This is excellent news for our Timmins employees and students! We ask that you continue to follow the direction of Northern College and to work with your direct supervisors to develop your back to campus planning.
