Updates to the <u>communication memo</u> circulated on December 20th, 2021 regarding the Winter Semester and access to campus due to the most recent <u>message</u> from the Ontario Government are shared below.

Further information regarding access to campus services for the period between January 4th and 30th, 2022 is noted below:

Campus Hours and Services (Jan 4th - 30th, 2022):

Brampton Campus:

All buildings will be open from 8:00 AM to 7:00 PM, Monday through Friday. Campus buildings will be closed on Saturdays and Sundays.

The Rapid Antigen Testing Clinic will operate by appointment only. Please email bramptonoperations@algomau.ca to arrange an appointment time.

Access and student card pick-up and returns will be put on hold until January 31st, 2022.

Please note that health screening is still required every time you access campus.

Sault Ste. Marie Campus:

The Main Building will be open from 8:00 AM to 6:00 PM, Monday to Friday. Access to the building is available through Doors U and Z only.

The CC Building will remain closed to the general public, but accessible through the East and West doors for those with approved swipe access.

The Rapid Antigen Testing Clinic will operate by appointment only. Please email covid@algomau.ca to arrange an appointment time.

Please note that health screening is still required every time you access campus.

In-Person Gatherings:

All in-person gatherings will be cancelled until January 30th, 2022.

Arthur A Wishart Library - Sault Ste. Marie:

The Library will be closed from January 4th to January 24th, 2022 with curbside pick-up availability.

George Leach Centre - Sault Ste. Marie Campus

The George Leach Centre will be closed as of January 5th until public health guidelines allow it to re-open.
