MEMO: Important Winter Semester COVID-19 Information - UPDATE

As we plan for the return of in-person, on campus activities and learning for both Brampton and Sault Ste. Marie campuses, please find updated details on services or changes to process that will be in effect as of February 7, 2022 below.

For our Timmins campus family, please follow all Northern College directions on access to campus, screening, in-person learning and safety protocols.

Campus Hours and Services as of February 7, 2022 unless specified:

Brampton Campus:

All buildings will be open from 8:00 AM to 10:30 PM, Monday to Friday, and 9:00 AM to 9:00 PM on Saturdays and Sundays.

Access and student card pick up and drop off will be available in the Welcome Centre from 9:00 AM to 12:00 PM Monday to Friday, and from 1:00 PM to 4:00 PM Tuesday and Thursday.

All student services will be offered virtually at this time (see below for more information).

Sault Ste. Marie Campus:

The Main Building (Shingwauk Hall and North Wing) will be open from 8:00 AM to 11:00 PM, Monday to Friday and 12:00 PM to 6:00 PM on weekends. Access to the building is available through Doors U and Z only.

The Convergence Centre will be open from 8:00 AM to 8:00 PM Monday to Thursday and 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM each Friday. The building will be closed on Saturday and Sunday. Access to the

building is available through the Main Entrance doors or by the East and West doors for those with pre-approved swipe access.

Entering campus:

Please ensure you have reviewed the changes to our screening policy.

- Vaccine verification will be conducted by the Verify Ontario government app. Download
 your updated certificate with QR code through here. Please ensure to have a piece of
 ID available to present at the door with the QR code.
- Health screening by the TrakrSafety app

Anyone entering campus will be asked to present their valid Verify Ontario Vaccine Information to the screeners. Individuals may also be asked to present their screening information.

It is recommended that to avoid crowding and line-ups, everyone completes the health screening prior to arriving on campus.

As a reminder, all failed health screenings will have to be investigated and approved by covid@algomau.ca before access to campus is granted.

For those Requiring Rapid Testing:

The Rapid Antigen Testing Clinic, for both campuses will operate **by appointment only**. Please email covid@algomau.ca to arrange an appointment time.

Changes to Mask Policy:

Please review the updated mask policy <u>here</u>. Please note that scarves and balaclavas are no longer approved face coverings. We encourage everyone to wear 3 ply medical grade masks or layer your cloth mask with a medical grade mask.

In-Person Gatherings:

All in-person gatherings will be suspended until February 21, 2022.
