

## Teaching and Learning Fellowship



The purpose of the Teaching & Learning Fellowship is to support and promote excellence in teaching & learning at Algoma University. Applications may be made for funding to support scholarly activities in a teaching & learning area related to the needs of the University and the interests of the recipient of the grant.

Applications also may be made to bring speakers or consultants to Algoma U to disseminate information related to teaching & learning, and fall within the scope described in the call for applications that may vary from year to year. In 2022, for example, the Teaching and Learning and Technical Support Committee welcomed applications for funding for projects that focused on the following themes:

- Using technology to enhance learning;
- Adapting teaching and learning practices to meet student needs as we transition out of COVID-19;
- Decolonizing and Indigenizing curricula, decolonizing teaching practices, or integrating Indigenous ways of knowing into existing curriculum;
- Integrating international and intercultural perspectives and content into teaching, enhancing the learning experience of international students, or fostering international and domestic student engagement;
- Designing innovative experiential learning opportunities that use novel approaches for students;
- Developing interdisciplinary content for existing courses or collaborating with a team of faculty in disciplines other than your own to create and deliver new interdisciplinary courses;
- Fostering active and collaborative learning.



## **Scope of Fellowship**

The fellowship does not normally cover projects for which other funding is available, or basic curriculum development or activities that are part of a faculty member's normal workload. It also does not cover student travel or related expenses, or a faculty member's travel to teach away from his/her regular campus, or the wages of students hired by faculty members. When sums of money required are larger than the amount of the fellowship, applicants are encouraged to search out matching funds. The fellowship may cover all or only part of your actual expenses.

## **Eligibility**

All Algoma University full-time or part-time teaching faculty are eligible to apply.

**The call for applications** and related details are sent out in the winter semester of each academic year by the Director of the Teaching Learning Centre to all full-time and part-time faculty.
