

MSC in BIOLOGY - PRE-APPLICATION FAQ

Please review the questions and answers below before submitting your application for the Master of Science in Biology Program.

Q: I am an international applicant and my English language test results fall slightly below the requirements as stated on the website (for example, my overall IELTS test score meets the requirement, but I scored below 6.5 in one band)? Can I still apply? Minimum requirements are not subject to revision during an active application period. Those who do not meet the minimum requirements will not be recommended for admission.

Q: Can I submit additional documentation, such as my resume, CV or employment records to support my application or replace one of the required documents or minimum requirements?

No. While we appreciate the professional accomplishments and competencies each applicant brings, we will not request or consider documents that are in addition to what is stated on our website.

Q: Can I be admitted if a supervisor has not been identified by the required application deadline?

No. Applicants will not be admitted until a Supervisor has been secured and confirmation was received.

Q: Will a Supervisor be assigned to me or is it my responsibility to secure one? The Applicant is responsible for discussing thesis research supervision with a Biology Faculty member and obtaining confirmation of supervision.

Q: If the Official transcript will take longer to arrive, can my application be assessed and be offered conditional admission?

No. An application file is considered incomplete without an official transcript and it will not be processed until all required documents are received. Conditional offers are not issued in the Master's program.
